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

#### **Course Description:**

The 2023 Eastern Montana Medicine Conference offers clinical education to primary care providers (MD, DO, PA, NP) and allied health professionals in Eastern Montana. The content covers a range of general clinical review topics that are particularly challenging to evaluate and treat in the frontier primary care setting. Updates, case studies, and clinical strategies for patient evaluation and management in these areas will be presented in an informal atmosphere that facilitates audience participation and discussion.
